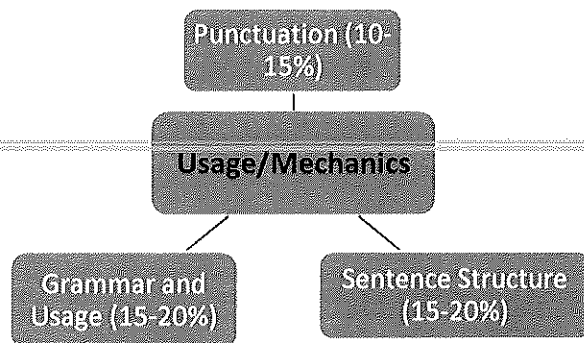

Content covered on the ACT English Test:



Punctuation: Tests your knowledge of punctuation rules, particularly as punctuation affects meaning.

Grammar and Usage: Tests things like subject-verb agreement, agreement between modifiers and the word modified, verb formation, pronoun case, etc.

Sentence Structure: Tests your understanding of relationships between and among clauses, placement of modifiers, and shifts in how a sentence is constructed.

Strategy: Tests how well you develop a topic by choosing what is appropriate to an essay's audience and purpose, judging what should be added, deleted, or revised, etc.

Organization: Tests how well you organize ideas and choose effective opening, transitional, and closing sentences.

Style: Tests how well you choose precise and appropriate words, maintain the tone of an essay, avoid wordiness, etc.
