The following scholarship opportunities are currently available in the counseling office:

The Gerber Foundation Merit Scholarship Program is for students who demonstrate leadership qualities, participation in school/community activities, high moral character and a constructive attitude. **Your GPA must be between a 2.0 and 3.70** to apply. Apply on line at www.gerberfoundation.org. Deadline is February 28.

The Society of Automotive Engineers is offering University Sponsored Scholarships and SAE Foundation Scholarships to students pursuing a degree in engineering or a related science. The American Legion Eagle Scout of the Year Award: You must be a registered active member of a troop, have received the Eagle Scout Award and must demonstrate service in church, school, scouting and community. Deadline is March 1.

The American Legion Oratorical Scholarship Contest is open to all students. A 3-5 minute speech based on an assigned topic is required. Deadline is November 21.

The GE-Reagan Foundation Scholarship honors the character and legacy of our 40th President, Ronald Reagan. Students must demonstrate leadership, integrity and citizenship. Apply at www.reaganfoundation.org/scholarships. Deadline is January 7.
